Position Summary

Responsible to provide personal home support services to community clients to support clients' independence and safety and the maintenance of a safe living environment.

Area Served:

- East of Don Mills Road / West of McCowan Road
- North of Ellesmere Road / South of Steeles Avenue East
- Care service area is Scarborough

<u>Responsibilities</u>

- 1. Provides personal support services to community clients and supportive housing clients
 - Provides personal care related activities of daily living: bathing, washroom assistance, changing incontinence products, dressing, personal hygiene and grooming and dental care according to the service plan
 - Assists with transferring, positioning of client, meal preparation, set-up and eating



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- Assists client with exercise programs under the direction of a health care professional when authorized by supervisor, including walking with the client
- Reminds clients to take medications (eg. blister pack)

2. Provides personal support services to Adult Day Program clients

- Provides personal care related activities in accordance with the client's service plan, including but not limited to: feeding, cleaning-up, toileting and hygiene, medication reminders.
- Assists with cleaning and personal hygiene assistance after client incontinence
- Escorts clients on SPLC vehicles during transportation to and from the program

3. Documents services and reports concerns and occurrences

4. Assist in daily program activities in the Adult Day Program

- Assists in program activity implementation and in encouraging client's participation in activities
- Assists with physical set up for program activities and daily routines
